ITS PROJECT: MULTINATIONAL ENCOUNTERS OF EUROPEAN UPPER SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS

Who for? Students aged 16 to 19 who are following a general, vocational or technological education.

How many encounters? Five to seven encounters per year.

Where? In France at the Royal Abbey of Saint-Jean-d'Angély and at its network of Centres abroad: Germany (Berlin), Spain (Santiago de Compostela), Italy (Fidenza and Partanna), Morocco (Marrakech), Tunisia (Djerba), Rumania (Calarasi), and soon in Guadeloupe.

History: Created in 1989, the Centre of Saint Jean d'Angély, the pilot of the project, works towards the promotion of citizenship and European culture for upper secondary school students and teachers through school exchanges. It believes that understanding European identity and solidarity between citizens should be experienced at an aged when prejudices have not yet formed and when meeting different nationalities is spontaneous and natural.

Youngsters need to experience the European construction with people of other nationalities before they are able to learn about it. They need to conquer their fear of others and give meaning to their desire to discover new things. They need to learn about their common roots, consider their differences, appreciate their complementarities and accept themselves before being able to understand themselves.

More than 300 schools have put their trust in the Centre.
