How to set up a wood workshop in a way that inspires and encourages productivity?

- 1. The machines should be spaced a minimum of 3 feet apart.
- 2. Machines should be placed so as not to impede traffic flow.
- 3. Material, both raw lumber and finished goods, needs to be moved into and out of the shop.
- 4. Provide a large door or a window for this.
- 5. Machines used in a sequence should be placed close together.
- 6. Proper lighting in a workshop is very important and natural ambient light or sunlight is ideal.
- 7. Place machines or workbenches so that bright sunlight will not shine directly into your eyes.
- 8. A general floor plan for your workshop should be drawn up.
- 9. If you have a large space available to you, plan for future additional equipment.
- 10. A lumber storage area is important, and can be either situated in the workshop or outside..
