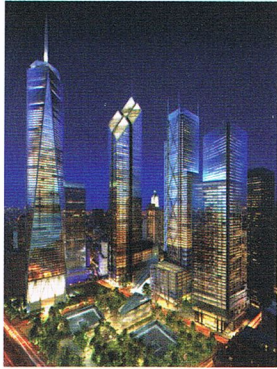


THE REBUILDING OF THE WORLD TRADE CENTER



The fully redeveloped WTC will include the Memorial and Museum, commercial office space, retail, and connections to public transit. The master plan for the site, created by Daniel Libeskind, calls for a spiral of new towers around the eight-acre Memorial. For the first few years that the Memorial is open, visitors can witness the rebuilding

taking place around them, including the construction of 1 World Trade Center just beyond the north pool, which at 1,776 feet, will be the tallest building in the United States. Just east of the south pool, 4 World



Trade Center will rise 72 floors and stand 977 feet tall. To the northeast of the Museum Pavilion will be the new WTC transit hub designed by Santiago Calatrava.
