/// Governance

Since a new framework of governance of the decentralised departments came into effect on the 1st January 2020, the jurisdiction of the rectors of the Academic Regions has been enlarged. All of the Academies have been maintained but are regrouped to form an Academic Region. (An Academy here is an Educational Administrative District.)

— THE RECTOR OF THE NOUVELLE-AQUITAINE ACADEMIC REGION

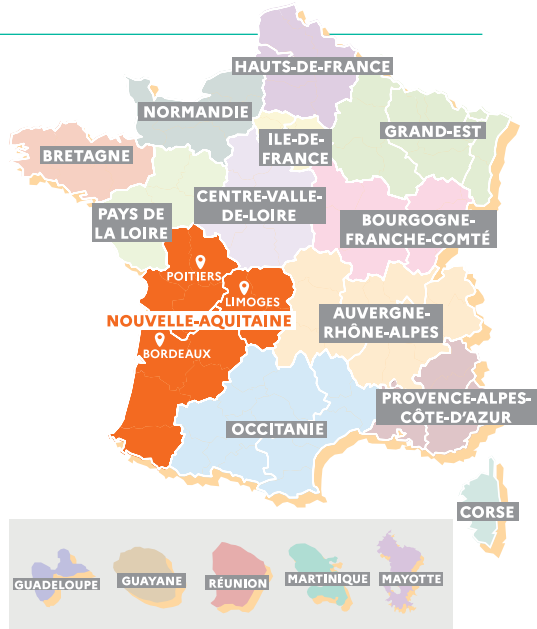
- Is chancellor of the universities.
- Liaises with local government collaborators (The Prefecture of the Region and the Regional Council).
- Fixes the strategic guidelines and coordinates the policies of the Academic Region :

- professional training courses and apprenticeships
- higher education, research and innovation
- information, careers advice and reducing school dropout rates
- digital education
- allocation of European funding
- state-region plan contract
- state buying policy and state real-estate policy
- European and International relations and cooperation
- policies concerning youth, public education, associations, civic engagement and sport.
- Makes decisions concerning the functional organisation of the Academic Region.
- Establishes the attributions and the pooling of resources of the regional departments and between the Academies.

— THE RECTORS OF THE ACADEMIES

3 Academies make up the Academic Region

- Fix the functional and geographical organisation of the Academy and the duties of each department.



- Decide and act on the strategic directions set on a regional level.
- Carry out the missions relating to the content and organisation of educational action and the management of personnel in schools
- Has authority over the academy inspectors and the academy directors of the Educational Authorities.

— DEPUTY RECTOR FOR HIGHER EDUCATION, RESEARCH AND INNOVATION

The Deputy Rector for Higher Education, Research and Innovation carries out the missions given by the Rector of the Academic Region, University Chancellor, in collaboration with the rectors of the Academies of Limoges and Poitiers.

He is in charge of projects relating to Higher Education and Research in the Academic Region. He follows and accompanies Higher Education and Research in the region in addition to the real-estate transactions of the Higher Education Establishments. He ensures the continuity between schools and Higher Education and provides regional monitoring of the Teacher Training Establishments

— THE SECRETARY GENERAL OF THE ACADEMIC REGION

The Secretary General of the Academic Region is the key administrator in support of the Rector of the Academic Region.

He is responsible for designing and implementing the new functional and geographical organisation of the departments of the Academic Region (regional departments and inter-regional services). In order to do this, he manages all regional services and has at their disposal the departments within the Academy and the Academic Region. He is responsible for the regional budget and coordinates the collective bodies and the links with the partners of the Academic Region.



The roadmap brings together all of the actors in the Academic Region and guides the action of the Rector of the Academic Region as well as all of the Rectors and managers within the Academic Region in a multi-annual framework.

The resulting actions are regularly monitored by the Regional Academic Committee. They are enriched with a section dedicated to youth, engagement and sport.

The strategic directions and the actions led on a regional level aim to reinforce the expertise by mutualising practices for the benefit of users, particularly via actions decided in each Academy taking into account the territorial characteristics according to the principal of subsidiarity.

Ambitions of the Roadmap 2021-2023 in the Nouvelle-Aquitaine Academic Region

Conduct a policy of regional direction to **reinforce ambition and facilitate career choice for pupils in a secure environment**, with particular attention being placed on reducing social and territorial inequalities.

Help learners (pupils, apprentices, students) to **develop the mindset of a European and global citizen** in order to **contribute to their empowerment**.

Reinforce the visibility and the coherence of **actions in favour of student life** (fighting against social insecurity, lowering student dropout rates and promoting cultural and sporting activities).



Improve the rate of students **going into Higher Education**.

Develop the digital skills of all of the actors.

Build on a dynamic, pluriannual **training plan** linked to an ambitious policy for the development of the label **'Careers and Qualifications Campus'**.*

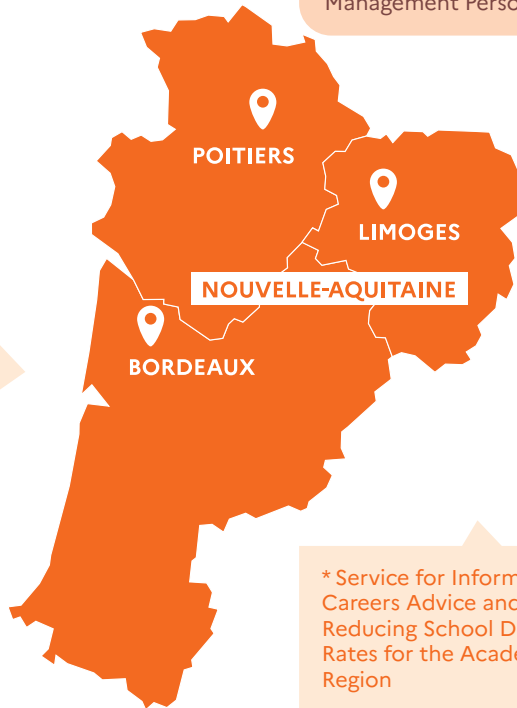
