Snakes and ladders game

Material:

The snakes and ladders board a dice 6 counters (one for each player) a set of identity cards a set of questions cards

Instructions

Make up identity cards and prepare questions to challenge them.

Toss the dice to determine number of squares the counter should be moved.

When a player lands on a square containing the bottom of a ladder or the tail-end of a snake, he is challenged. The player on his left picks up a "questions card" and asks him one of the written questions. If the answer is correct, the player moves up to the square at the top of the ladder or he stays at the tail-end of the snake. If not, he stays at the bottom of the ladder or he moves down the head of the snake.

Goal: The first player to reach the end of the route by the exact toss of the dice, wins the game.
