



QUEEN ELIZABETH II

- 1- Elizabeth Alexandra Mary was born in London, England, on April 21, 1926.
- 2- King George VI, who was seriously ill, died in his sleep. At the age of just 25, Elizabeth II became queen of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland.
- 3- So Elizabeth became the heir to the throne. The young princess began training for her future duties. She also studied history, languages, and music at home with her younger sister, Margaret Rose.
- 4- Elizabeth married Philip Mountbatten in 1947.
- 5- In 2002 Elizabeth reached her Golden Jubilee, or 50 years as queen.
- 6- Ten years later the queen celebrated her Diamond Jubilee, marking her 60 years on the British throne.
- 7- She was officially crowned as the Queen of the United Kingdom on June 2, 1953, an event that more than 20 million people watched on their TVs.

8- When Elizabeth's grandfather George V died in 1936, his eldest son (Elizabeth's uncle) became King Edward VIII. But Edward was in love with American divorcée Wallis Simpson. He abdicated the crown, as a consequence Elizabeth's father became King George VI.

9- Prince Philip passed away on April 9, 2021, at age 99.

10- She had her first child, a son, in 1948. His name was Charles.

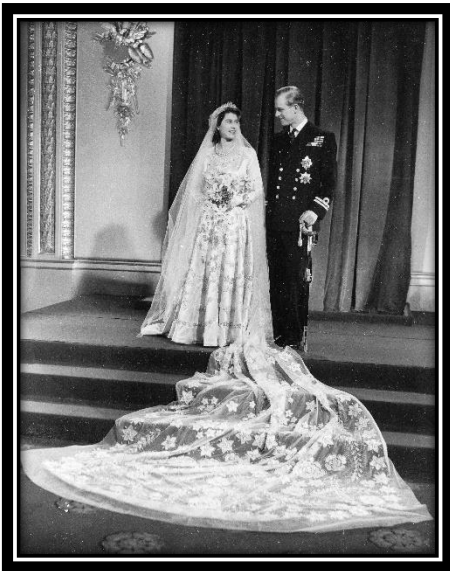
11- In 1981, 32-year-old Charles married Diana Spencer. Charles and Diana gave birth to Elizabeth's grandsons Prince William in 1982, and Prince Harry in 1984.

12- In 2022 she celebrated her Platinum Jubilee, marking 70 years of reign.

13- The Queen died on September 8th 2022 in her castle of Balmoral, Scotland.

14- During her reign she travelled a lot, she visited more than 100 countries on six continents. She didn't visit Madagascar, Cuba, Israel, or Peru.

THE KING DIES PEACEFULLY IN HIS SLEEP

Princess Elizabeth Becomes Queen While In Africa

NATION IS STUNNED BY THE NEWS

It was announced from Sandringham at 10.45 a.m. to-day that the King, who retired to rest last night in his usual health, passed peacefully away in his sleep early this morning.

In accordance with constitution, Princess Elizabeth—now in Kenya—became Queen immediately on the death of the King. It is the first time in British history that a Sovereign has acceded the Throne while abroad in the Commonwealth.

The whole nation and Commonwealth was stunned by the news. The Ministry was not yesterday both during the morning and afternoon and everybody is expected to be in the very best of health.

The Queen and Princess Margaret are at the moment at Sandringham. It is reported that they were staying on the Norfolk estate at the home of Mr. Edward Kemp, the well-known sportsman, in Norfolk, in the afternoon of the 9th.

Princess Elizabeth, in London, is still attending Lady's at York, in Kenya, and is due to leave to-morrow for Mombasa.
