

How Is Saint Patrick's Day Celebrated?

People celebrate Saint Patrick's Day by having a party or a parade, wearing special clothes and eating party food. People decorate with and wear the colour green, which reminds them of Ireland and Saint Patrick. Green is one of the colours on the Irish flag. It also reminds them of the shamrock leaf which Saint Patrick is often associated with. Some people go to church on Saint Patrick's Day.




