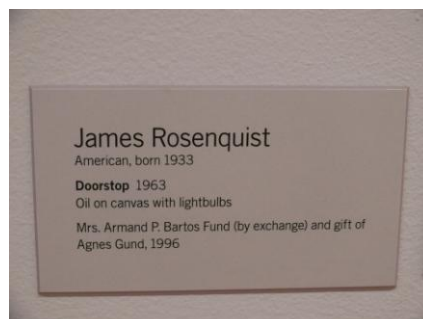
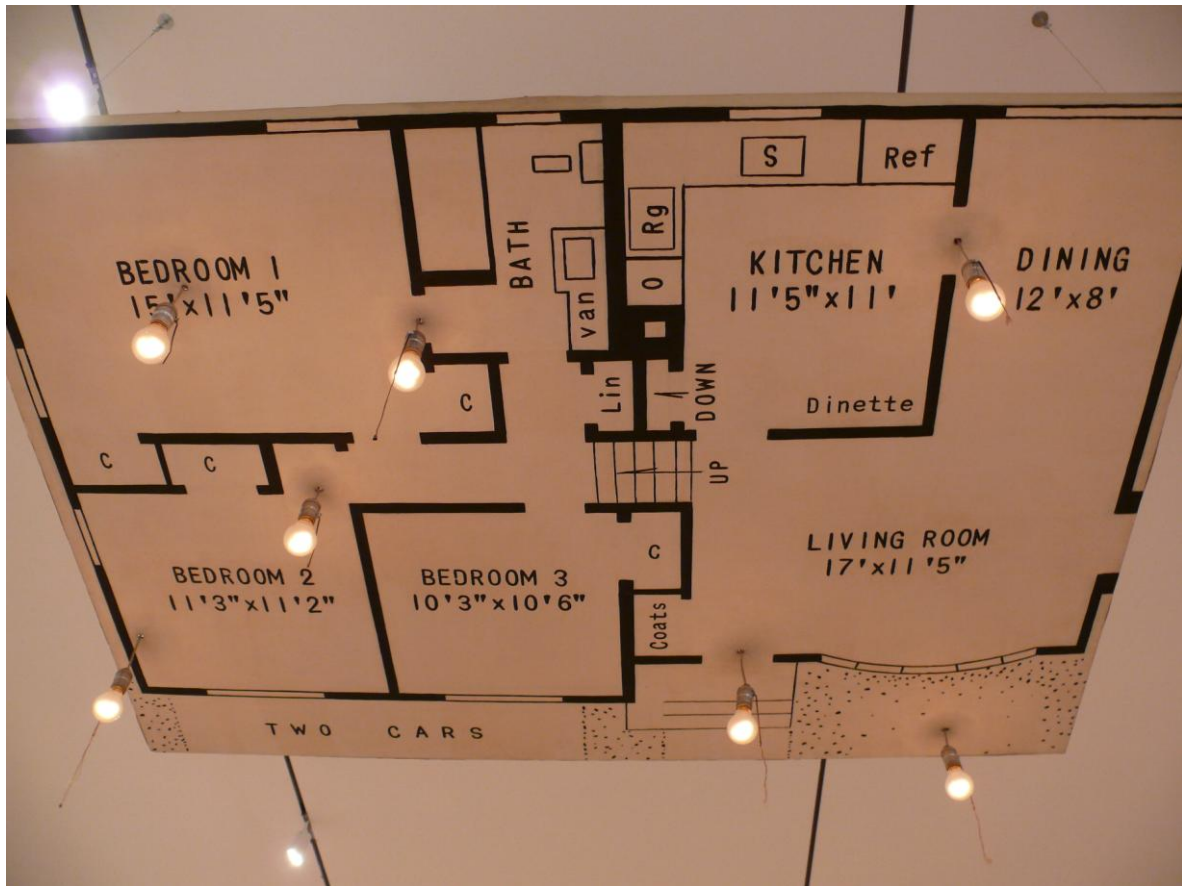


3DP6/ Unit 3/ My house/ EOC : décrire mon environnement quotidien



He was born in North Dakota (USA) and grew up as an only child. His parents, Louis and Ruth Rosenquist are of Swedish descent. His mother, who was also a painter, encouraged her son to have an artistic interest. Rosenquist studied painting at the University of Minnesota from 1952 to 1954. In 1955, at the age of 21, he moved to New York City. From 1957 to 1960, he earned his living as a billboard painter. This was perfect training, as it turned out, for an artist about to explode onto the pop art scene. Like other pop artists (Andy Warhol, for example),

Rosenquist adapted the visual language of advertising and pop culture to the context of fine art.
