The *Première AGORA* class, from Jean Rostand technical high school, organized a conference on February 11th, 2025.

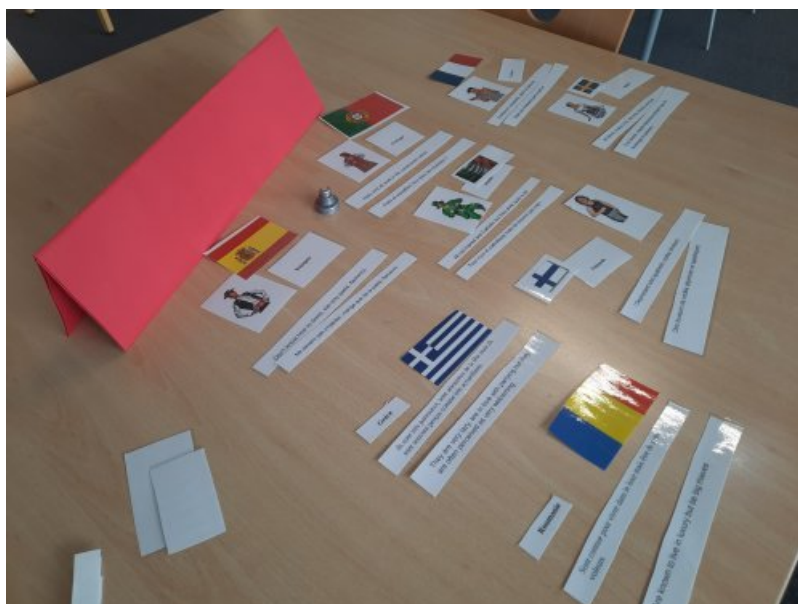
► The *Première AGORA* class organized **a conference** on February 11th, 2025.
