



From Surgères to Cyprus: Building skills across borders

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Descriptif :

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► As part of their final vocational training for the professional baccalaureate, a second group of **four students completed a four-week internship in March / April 2025**.



► This **experience abroad** enabled them to **refine their technical skills and gain international work exposure** ahead of graduation.



- Mrs. Garbaczinski (English teacher) and Mr. Marzin (carpentry teacher), who accompanied the students on their return trip, seized the opportunity while in Cyprus **to secure a new partnership with a second woodworking company in Limassol for future internships.**
- Next year, in return, **two Cypriot students will be hosted by a French company** and will benefit from the European program in the same way.
- **This growing Erasmus+ collaboration** not only enhances **students' career prospects** but also **strengthens our institution's reputation in vocational training.**
