1. (returning with the food) Here you are. Enjoy your meal!
2. Thank you.
1. Can I get you anything else?
2. No thanks. I'd like the bill, please.
1. That'll be 6.75.
2. Here you are. Keep the change!
1. Thank you! Have a good day!
2. Bye.
