WHAT IS IT ?

- * a faithful **reconstruction** of the original **16th century** Globe theatre which was co-owned and run by Shakespeare
- * you can **stand** in the open-air pits or **sit** in the stalls
- * picture yourself attending the first performance of **Hamlet, King Lear, Macbeth**

HISTORY

- * the **old theatre opened in 1559** and **burnt down in 1613 during the performance of Henry VIII** when a **canonball** set fire to the thatched roof
- * the **New Globe opened in 1997**
- * it's **now opened from May to October**

WHERE IS IT ?

On the **south bank of the River Thames** next door to the **Tate Modern**
5-minute walk from the **Blackfriars tube station**
